A meeting of the Islip Resource Recovery Agency was convened at 3:30 p.m. in the Town Board Room of Islip Town Hall, 655 Main Street, Islip, NY 11751. A Quorum was present for this Agency Board Meeting.

On a motion of Jorge Guadrón, seconded by John Lorenzo and unanimously approved the minutes from the March 11, 2025, Agency Board Meeting were approved.

On a motion of Jorge Guadrón, seconded by Michael McElwee and unanimously approved, a resolution was passed authorizing the President to enter into a contract with Cashin Associates, P.C. for the calendar years 2026, 2027 and 2028; with the option to extend the contract for three, one (1) year extensions; to provide Professional Engineering Services related to Groundwater and Leachate Monitoring, Sampling, Assessment and Reporting at the Blydenburgh Road Landfill, Cleanfill Phase 1 and 2.


On a motion of Michael McElwee, seconded by John Lorenzo and unanimously approved, a resolution was passed authorizing the President to Execute Extension Year 3 of 4 of an existing contract with Clear Flo Technologies inc. for disposal of leachate generated at Agency Landfills as an Alternate Disposal Facility to those provided by the County of Suffolk.

On a motion of Jorge Guadrón, seconded by John Lorenzo and unanimously approved, a resolution was passed authorizing the President to enter into a Contract Extension between the Agency and Pace Analytical Services, Inc. for calendar year 2026; for Professional Services Related to Laboratory Analytical Services for Groundwater and Ash Analysis for all Islip Resource Recovery Agency (IRRA) sites.

On a motion of Chairwoman Carpenter, seconded by Michael McElwee and unanimously approved, a resolution was passed authorizing the Adoption of the Recommended Budget of the Islip Resource Recovery Agency for the Fiscal Year 2026.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned on a motion of James O'Connor, seconded by Jorge Guadrón, and unanimously approved.
